At B&D Print Services Ltd, we are committed to supporting environmental initiatives, including prevention of pollution and we acknowledge that our operations have an effect on the local, regional and national environment.

As part of our ISO 14001:2015 accreditation, it is our intention that our operations and products will generate the lowest level of waste possible by adopting sensible recycling practices throughout the company. We will ensure the consideration of environmental issues in all business strategies and initiatives.

Where possible, we will continue to purchase materials and resources through renewable sources including our paper which will be sourced through FSC Certified suppliers.

We will continue to use a process-less plate maker and vegetable-based inks to reduce our chemical waste. Any chemical waste will be disposed of by an approved waste disposal company.

We are working to reduce our carbon footprint by carbon offsetting paper purchases, switching to LED Lighting, ensuring the use of the efficient heating/cooling methods and the use of soft proofing. Where feasible, we also encourage staff to walk/cycle to work and provide a secure bike shed and shower facilities.

We promote the use of continuous improvement practices, continually developing and training our staff to enable full employee involvement, ensuring quality in all our printed products and services is maximised. We will regularly assess our environmental performance through management review, where the setting and reviewing of objectives and targets will take place.
